

Louis Riel's Trial



Prime Minister Sir John A. McDonald ordered the trial to be convened in Regina, Saskatchewan where Riel was tried before a jury of six English and Scottish Protestants, all from the area surrounding the city. The trial began on 28 July 1885, and lasted only five days. Pictured is Riel testifying at his trial.
