



Thomas Scott

Employed by the Canadian government as a surveyor during the Red River Rebellion, Scott was arrested and imprisoned in Upper Fort Garry by Louis Riel and his men while trying to attack the fort along with 34 other volunteers. Unlike most of the prisoners, Scott was an extraordinarily difficult, opinionated and verbally abusive prisoner who refused to acknowledge his captors' illegal authority.

Scott made an attempt to escape but was recaptured by Riel's men, was tried then executed for committing insubordination.
